Belief

The **Isaiah 40 Foundation** is a Christian organization which believes the Lordship of Jesus Christ can be exercised over every aspect of life, to renew and integrate the broken pieces of our lives in His love and mercy through the power of the Holy Spirit to the Glory of God the Father.

Purpose

The **Isaiah 40 Foundation** is set up to support and facilitate a Christian ministry of Prayer Counselling and Teaching in the areas of healing and personal wholeness. This is accomplished through teaching workshops, group/individual prayer counselling sessions and other related activities.

The **Isaiah 40 Foundation** is committed to the use of active prayer within the counselling process to recognize and affirm the Presence of Jesus Christ as the continual Source of healing.

Doctrinal Statement

The **Isaiah 40 Foundation** holds to the following:

- We believe in one God, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- We believe that our Lord Jesus Christ is fully man and fully God, the only begotten Son of the Father, that He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered, was crucified, died and was buried, and was raised physically from the dead. He ascended to the right hand of the Father and will come again in power and glory to judge the living and the dead.

- We believe that our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, through His incarnation, sinless life, obedience to the will of the Father, sacrificial death, glorious resurrection and sending of the Holy Spirit, has broken the power of sin and death and restores us to communion with the Father, enabling us to live joyfully in the power of His risen life together with the whole body of Christian believers.
- We believe that the Church, the Body of Jesus Christ, is formed of all those who know Him as their Saviour and Lord, who are grafted into that Body through Baptism by water and the Holy Spirit and nourished through the Eucharist and the Proclamation of the Word.
- We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the inspired Word of God to be used for the formulation of doctrine and reproof, correction and instruction in right living, so that everyone may be capable of demonstrating a victorious and joyful Christian witness.
- We believe that the Eternal Life promised to us in the Scriptures commences when we are incorporated into Christ, and reaches its completion in the resurrection, when renewed totally in body, soul and spirit, we enter fully into our inheritance as children of God.



Guidelines for Associate Membership

Associate Membership is open to anyone who accepts the **Belief, Purpose and Doctrinal Statement** of the **Isaiah 40 Foundation**.

An Associate Member would be willing to provide support in the following ways:

Opportunities for volunteer service include the cleaning and maintenance of the building, clerical work, and hospitality tasks including dish-washing, making up guest rooms, plant watering and food preparation for special events such as Open Houses and the Annual General Meeting.
